“Attitude of Gratitude”

I always think of November as Gratitude Month. Not that I am not grateful other months of the year, but I take time out especially to focus on gratitude during November, the month of Thanksgiving. In the dictionary, gratitude, thankfulness and gratefulness are somewhat interchangeable. In the thesaurus, grace is listed as a synonym for gratitude. For all who know me well, you know I am forever grateful for God’s grace.

In Ephesians 2:5-8, Paul tells us, “though we were spiritually dead because of the things we did against God, he gave us new life with Christ. You have been saved by God’s grace. And he raised us up with Christ Jesus so that for all future time he could show the very great riches of his grace by being kind to us in Christ Jesus. I mean that you have been saved by grace through believing. You did not save yourselves; it was a gift from God.”

For my ever wondering heart?

Session Summary

Clerk of Session, Sandi Thompson

The regular monthly meeting of the Bethany Session was held on October 18, 2016. The meeting was opened in prayer at 6:35 pm in the church office and a quorum was declared present.

For the opening devotional, Chandler Salmon showed a short video about family, love and prayer in difficult times and then read several scriptures from the books of Isaiah and Matthew. We are all encouraged to continue expressing our love for each other and pray continually during this difficult time in the life of Bethany and the world. Rev. Myers then closed this time with prayer.

The financial report of September was reviewed and Elders were given the opportunity to clarify and ask questions. The financial picture looks more positive for September.

The prayer list was reviewed and updated. Prayer cards were sent to those in need. Dr. Myers led us in prayer for all those on the list and others mentioned.

Dr. Myers availability for worship at Bethany was reviewed and a calendar was developed. Dr. Myers will preach November 20 through December 25, 2016. This includes the Thanksgiving Eve and Christmas Eve services.

The following items were addressed during the Clerk's report:

- the Docket and minutes pending any corrections that need to be made were approved.
- our ending membership is now 122 with the passing of Delores "Dee" Norris on 10/10/16 and following the approval of a request received to transfer Rachel Commerford to the First Presbyterian Church of Tequesta, Florida .
- a thank you not was received from the family of Dee Norris and is posted on the bulletin board in the Assembly room.
- Sandi Thompson and Chris Mize will be the commissioners at the November 15, Presbytery Meeting in Fayetteville, at Fayetteville Presbyterian Church at 9 am.
- the Annual Meeting of the Corporation was approved to be scheduled for December 18, 2016.
- Rev. Nelson DeBrosse will be preaching October 23 through November 13.

Ministry Teams Highlights

- The work day on October 15 went well. The broken part on the playground has been repaired. The handrail on the front entrance steps is scheduled to be repaired next.
- The Thornwell offering "turkeys" will be distributed November 13 and collected the following Sunday, November 20.
- A welcome letter will be sent to first time visitors by the Mission and Outreach Ministry Team. They are also considering having a small gift to present to them on their first Sunday.
- The Mission and Outreach Team will be purchasing small pocket crosses for our members to give to those we encounter who seem to need Christ's love.
- Commitment Sunday is scheduled for October 23. All members are encouraged to bring their completed forms to church that Sunday.
- November 6 is Retired Educators Day and we will take time to recognize those in our congregation who contribute to our children's education.
- The Session is beginning the budget review process for 2017.

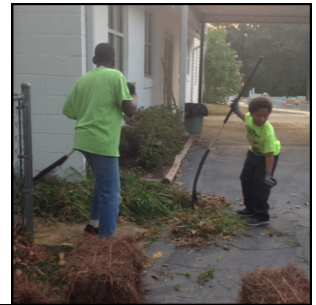


I would also like to thank everyone that contributes to the sack lunch program and encourage anyone that is able to come out and help on the last Saturday of every month.
